5. Be a resource to those coming after you.

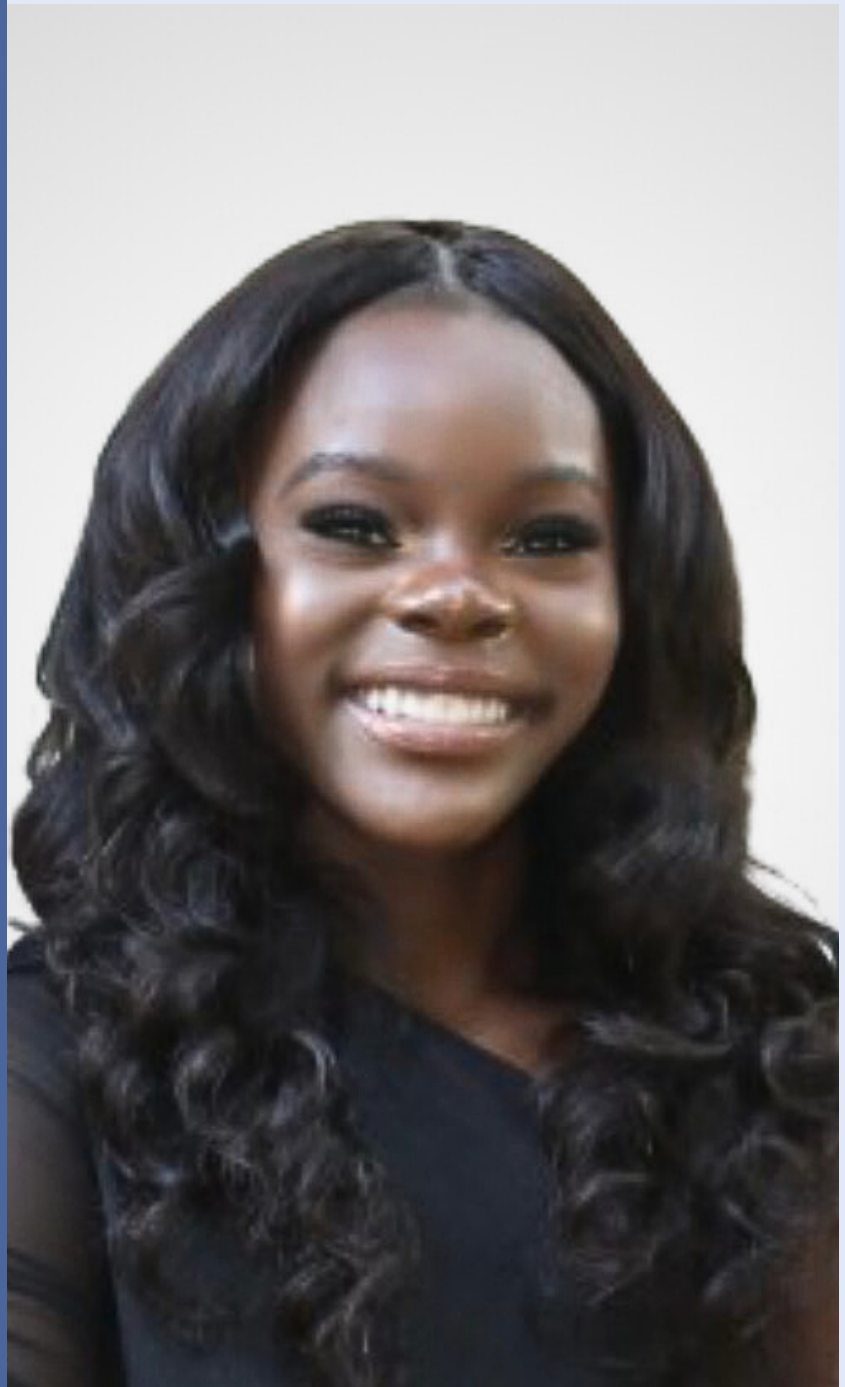
